"Play in your world. Die in ours."

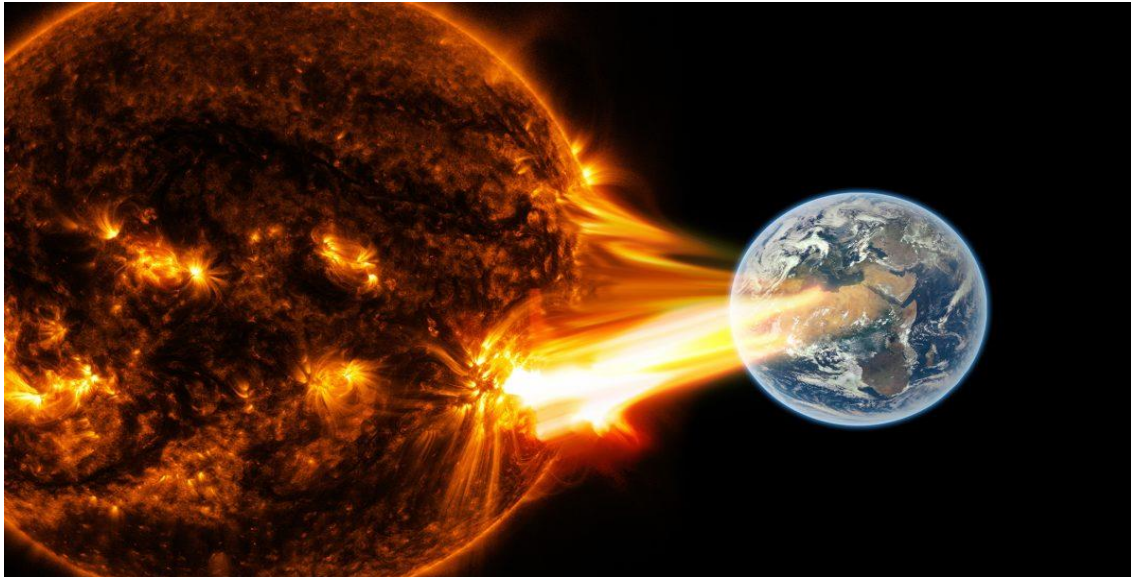

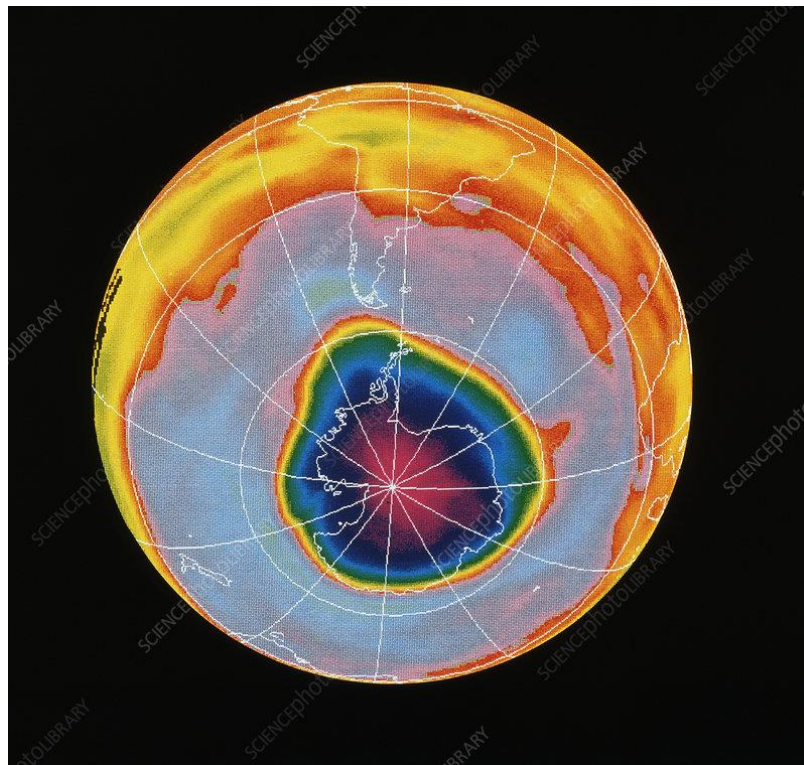
The drama opens at a cozy bar in McMurdo Station, Antarctica. (actual photo of the bar)

Superstorm? Global disaster? Get outa here – to the McMurdo Sound community:



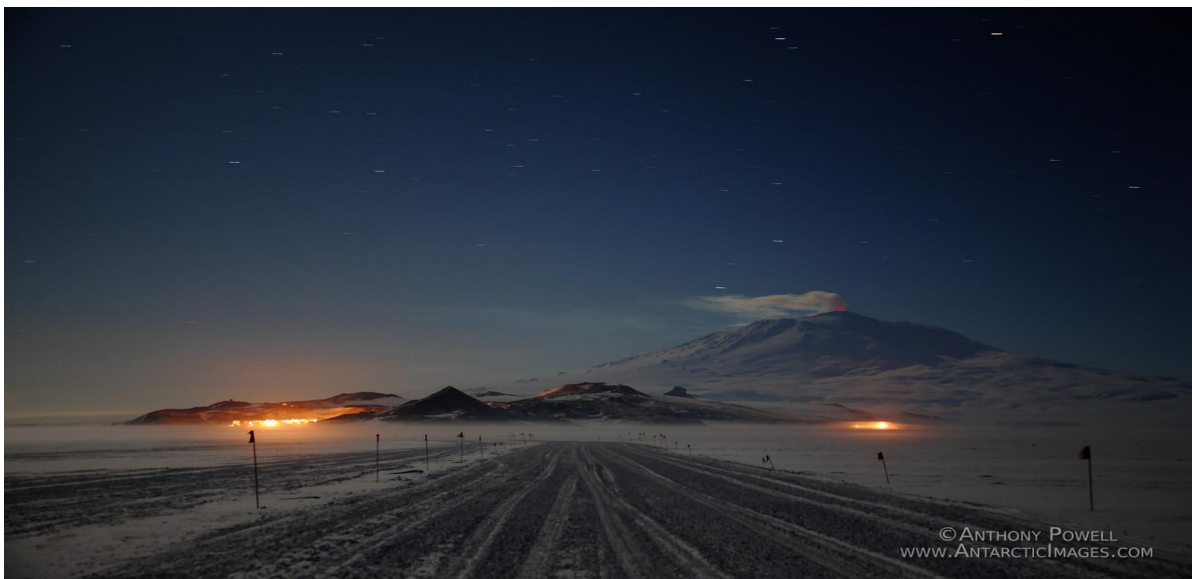
A few miles away from McMurdo are two volcanoes, Mr. Erebus (active) and Mt. Terror (a few miles away). Imagine all the cinematographic possibilities, especially at night and at dusk/dawn.



WACO's research lab, Ice Station Terror, is on the opposite side of Ross Ice Shelf, on the slopes of Mt. Terror where it slopes into the ocean.



McMurdo is on the left in the photo, Mt. Erebus on the right, Mt. Terror right (off the photo).



There are many remote research stations along the shore in Antarctica as possible locations.



The action in Act Three takes place at a drilling rig on the slopes of Mt. Terror.
