IMPORTANT NOTICE TO REGISTRANT

Registrant who believes he has a disqualifying defect.—If you believe that you have some defect which will disqualify you for service you may, on or before the 10th day of April, 1944, appear in person at the office of the Local Board, or, if you are unable by reason of such defect to personally appear, you may submit an affidavit from a reputable physician or an official statement by an authorized representative of a Federal or State agency to the effect that such physician has personal professional knowledge or such authorized representative has official knowledge of your defect, the character thereof, and that you are unable to personally appear due to the character of the defect. The Local Board may send you to the Local Board examining physician, and, if it does so, it shall be your duty to appear at the time and place designated by the Local Board to such examination as the examining physician shall direct. If the Local Board determines that your defect disqualify you for service you will receive a Notice of Classification (Form 57) advising you that you have been placed in Class IV-F. Unless prior to the date fixed for your preinduction physical examination, you receive such a Notice of Classification (Form 57) advising you that you have been placed in Class IV-F, you must report for your preinduction physical examination as directed.

Every registrant.—When you report for preinduction physical examination you will be forwarded to an induction station where you will be given a complete physical examination to determine whether you are physically fit for service. If you sign a Request for Immediate Induction (Form 219), and you are found qualified for service, you will be inducted immediately following the completion of your preinduction physical examination. Otherwise, upon completion of your preinduction physical examination, you will be returned to this Local Board. You will be furnished transportation and meals and lodgings when necessary. Following your preinduction physical examination you will receive a certificate issued by the commanding officer of the induction station showing your physical fitness for service or lack thereof.

If you fail to report for preinduction physical examination as directed, you will be delinquent and will be immediately ordered to report for induction into the armed forces. You will also be subject to fine and imprisonment under the provisions of section 11 of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended.

If you are so far from your own Local Board that reporting in compliance with this order will be a hardship and you desire to report to the Local Board in the area in which you are now located, take this order and go immediately to that Local Board and make written request for transfer for preinduction physical examination.

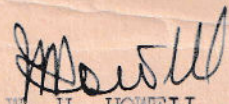

Gentleman:

In connection with his application for an appointment in the United States Naval Reserve, Mr. William Howard Clark has requested that we furnish you with either a statement of release or a statement of non-release.

Mr. Clark is a chemical engineer engaged in work directly in connection with the production of 100 octane number aviation gasoline. We filed Form DSS 42-A Special, requesting a continuation of Mr. Clark's occupational deferment, with the government agency responsible for endorsing and certifying to State Selective Service Headquarters deferments for technical men engaged in the 100 octane number aviation gasoline program. This agency has approved our request for Mr. Clark's deferment and forwarded their endorsement to the Director, Selective Service.

In our letter of April 20 we pointed out that we considered Mr. Clark a very capable engineer, and since he was in an essential occupation and because of our shortage of technical men, we were not in position to grant Mr. Clark a release. Our situation has not improved in this respect, and we are not in position to release him.
